

STASSE For Future Babysitters & Counselors in 8th-12th grade

As part of our Growing Up Lakeshore Program, your future care provider can learn how to be a professional babysitter. This program could open the door to possible job opportunities. Classes are taught by seasoned Lakeshore Children's Department staff, who will set participants up for success in multiple childcare settings. Certifications include a Red Cross CPR, First Aid and AED Certification, an understanding of child development basics, real-time shadowing and practice, and how to have fun while still being professional. This is an 8-course program with 7 classes and 10 hours of practical experience. Flexible enrollment options are available. Members can complete individual classes that interest them or register for the all 8 courses. Classes will meet in Caley's Corner on the 4th Floor.
